Warranty

TSA Canopies part of TJM Brendale Pty Ltd warrants your purchase of a new product to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for 1 year from your date of purchase.

It is a condition of the warranty that the product has been correctly installed by suitably qualified personnel and is used in accordance with accompanying instructions where provided.

This warranty will no longer apply where TSA Canopies considers (acting reasonably) there has been damage to the product as a result of an accident (for example collision), product alterations/modifications, incorrect installation, misuse, abuse or neglect. Additionally this warranty will not apply where there have been any alterations to the vehicle from the vehicle manufacturer's specifications, instructions or manual or the product purchased is not suitable for use on the vehicle.

The warranty is applicable for domestic household users only. Use of the product in racing, competition or for any commercial purposes including severe road conditions is not covered by this warranty.

TSA Canopies will provide you with a repair or exchange (where possible) for the product if it becomes defective during the warranty period; however the cost of removal and replacement is not covered by this warranty. You are required to pay for any expenses you incur in making or pursuing a claim under the warranty (including the costs of delivering the product you consider to be defective to TSA Canopies). The choice of repairing or replacing a defective product under warranty is at the absolute discretion of TSA Canopies.

TSA Canopies will not be liable to you or any third party in respect of any claim for injury, death, loss or damage to any person or property caused or arising out of the use of products sold by us, except to the extent that liability is imposed upon us by any statutory provisions that cannot be excluded.

Whilst TSA Canopies ensures all our products comply with relevant mandatory product safety standards, it is the sole responsibility of the purchasers to ensure their purchased product is suitable for use under the relevant law and regulations in their respective jurisdictions.

Making a claim
